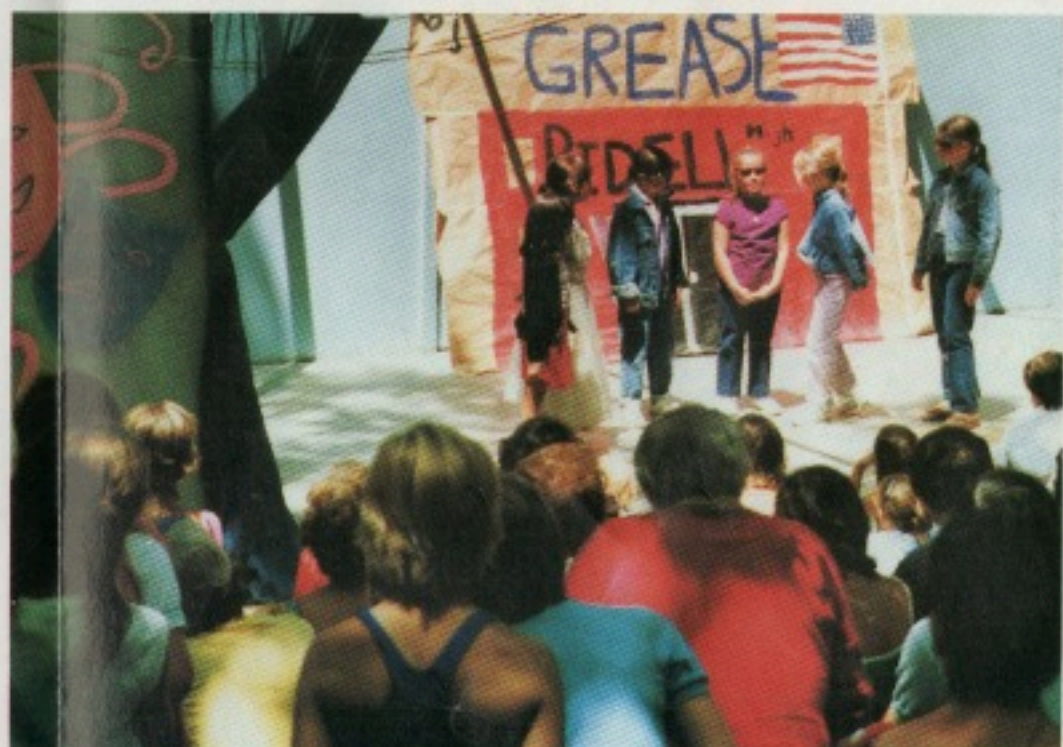
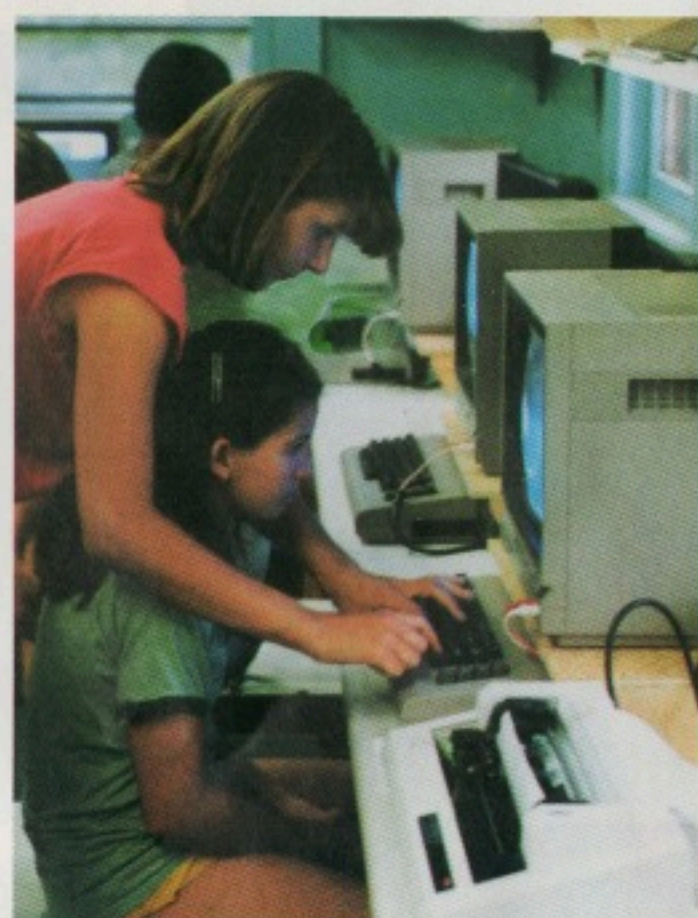

### ORGANIZATION

Established in 1957, Singing Oaks is a day camp for boys and girls 4-13 years old. A staff of trained men and women includes a registered nurse, American Red Cross swimming instructors, and professional teachers. Campers are grouped by grade and sex under the direct supervision of a group counselor at a 12-1 ratio. Pre-school boys and girls are placed together with a 6-1 ratio per counselor. When we include our activity instructors, the overall ratio is 4-1.

### PROGRAMS

Arts & crafts • singing • gymnastics • nature • swimming • dramatics • boating • fishing • riflery • dancing • tennis • basketball • archery • baseball • track • volleyball • soccer • computer literacy • horseback riding lessons. **Computer Literacy:** classes meet daily and are designed to develop an understanding of microcomputers, one computer per student. **Horseback Riding Lessons:** a series of four one-hour riding lessons are offered each

session. Additional lessons may be arranged. **Swimming:** each camper has two swim periods daily, one in the pool and the other in the lake. The Red Cross standards are used for both safety and instruction. **Meals:** each camper has a hot meal at lunchtime, 4 days a week, plus a cook-out once a week. Snacks are served each afternoon. **Additional charge:** horseback riding • computer literacy.
