

# Make a Milk Carton Bird Feeder

## Materials:

cardboard milk  
carton

X-acto knife or box cutter  
(Adult Use Only)

acrylic paint &  
paint brush

pen

foam or felt shapes

glue

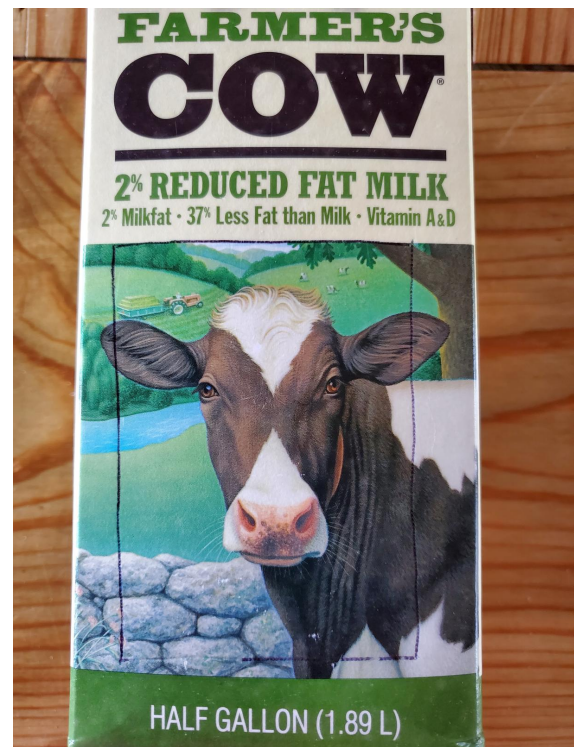
heave string

bird seed



## To make the bird feeder:

1. Get a cardboard milk carton, rinse it out and let it dry.
2. Using a pen, draw a vertical rectangle on the front and back of the carton



**3. Ask an adult to cut out the two rectangles using an X-acto knife or box cutter. (ONLY AN ADULT SHOULD DO THIS STEP.)**

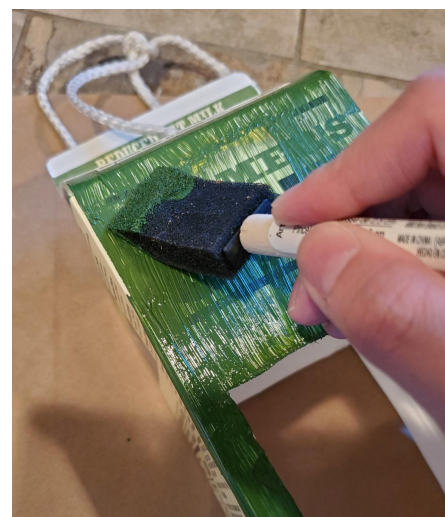


**4. Ask an adult to cut a small hole on the opposite side of the carton's spout. (ONLY AN ADULT SHOULD DO THIS STEP)**



**5. Use acrylic paint to paint your bird feeder.**

**It will need 2 or 3 coats of paint.**

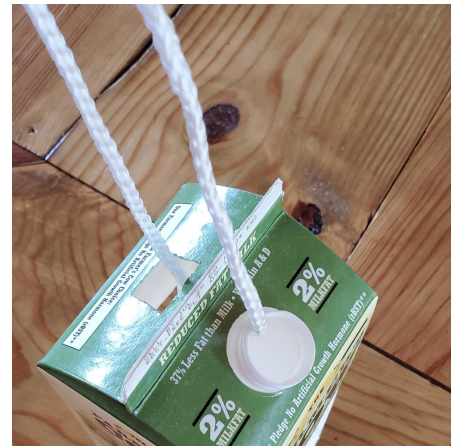


## 6. Get Creative!!

**You can use foam shapes, felt shapes or anything you'd like to decorate the bird feeder.**



**7. Loop a heavy piece of string through the top two holes.**



**8. Fill with bird seed and tie your bird feeder on a branch. Watch your feathery friends enjoy a snack!**
